Requirements

Students interested in the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program are admitted to Labette Community College on the same basis as other students, but admission to the college does not ensure admission into the Sonography Program. All students applying for the DMS program are required to have completed the following prior to acceptancee into the program:

Associates or Bachelors Degree with a medical component.

Mathematics, Physics (NOT required for students with Radiology Degree), Communitcations or Composition, Anatomy and Physiology, Medical Terminology.
