



## **WELDING INSTRUCTORS**

Two position openings are available. Instructors' responsibilities encompass all courses assigned, committees assigned, or other activities required or agreed upon between faculty members and administration as specified in the LCC Master Agreement and LCC Policy/Procedures Manual. Instructors must demonstrate computer literacy in appropriate computer software and be able to demonstrate fluency in written and oral communications.

### **Required Qualifications**

Required is a Bachelor's or higher degree in Technology/Technology Management/Technology Leadership or similar. A minimum of two years of instruction at secondary or postsecondary institution and five years non-teaching work experience along with AWS Certification.

### **Preferred Qualifications**

Preferred is a Master's degree in Technology/Technology Management/Technology Leadership, at least three years of community college teaching experience, knowledge of pedagogy which includes curriculum design research-based teaching strategies, and assessment of student learning such as course outcomes' assessment.

Applicants should also have experience with online teaching, academic advising, and computer skills. Other helpful experience could include directing student clubs and other teaching experiences.

### **Job Expectations**

The successful applicant will be expected to serve on LCC committees, maintain office hours, demonstrate fluency in written and oral communications, and work effectively with colleagues, administration, students, and adjunct instructors.
