

Applicants must have completed a 2009-2010 FAFSA to determine eligibility for the Summer semester. You may do so at www.fafsa.ed.gov. You must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours that apply towards your LCC degree in the Summer semester before Summer aid can be determined.

Please note: FIRST day of July classes is the LAST day to turn in all required forms to complete your Financial Aid file for the Summer Session. This includes Entrance Counseling, Entrance Counseling Learning Path and MPN's for the Federal Direct Student Loan AND the Summer Financial Aid Application.

The Anticipated Federal Funds Disbursement date is scheduled for Thursday, July 29, 2010.

Summer General Financial Aid Information PLEASE READ

Pell will be awarded to eligible degree seeking students who

- A. Have not used all or any of their Pell eligibility for 2009-2010 (incoming freshmen or those students who were not enrolled as a full-time student for both Fall and Spring of 2009-2010)

OR

- B. Have already received all of their 2009-2010 Pell eligibility and are enrolled in at least 6 hours for Summer and meet SAP and all other eligibility requirements.

Federal Direct Stafford Student Loan will be awarded to students if

- A. There is loan eligibility available. (If a student received the full loan amount in the Fall/Spring semesters, they may not have any eligibility left.)

AND

- B. The completed Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note are on file in the Financial Aid Office. (A new MPN must be completed for Summer 2010, even if you received a loan in the Fall 2009 and/or Spring 2010 semesters.)

*****All aid recipients must be making satisfactory academic progress. Your progress will be checked after Spring grades have been reported. If you do not meet SAP requirements Summer aid offered to you will be revoked and will not be disbursed. You may lose your Summer eligibility.**

Step 1

Register for Summer classes. **DON'T DELAY! Your Summer aid cannot be processed until you have registered!**

Step 2

Complete Summer Financial Aid Application. If this is your first semester at LCC, make sure that all other paperwork has been received by the financial Aid Office and your file is complete. If you received aid at LCC in the Fall and/or Spring, your file is already complete and will only need this Summer Application.

Step 3

Complete a new Master Promissory Note if you wish to apply for a Federal Direct Stafford Student Loan. The completed **Entrance Counseling** and **Entrance Counseling Learning Path** must also be on file in our office if you have not previously completed them for our institution.) **See Loan Procedures**

Step 4

Visit with the Financial Aid Office about your Summer eligibility
